



Project Goal: The goal of the project is to create a multidisciplinary/multiprofessional learning practical laboratories (hub) promoting employment in the higher education system, which will be used for psychology and social work students as a place of practice, where an analysis of various jobs for people with disabilities will be prepared, and specific work-related skills of disabled/disabled people will be determined; and it will become possible to promote the social integration of people with disabilities and their involvement in the supportive community;

The course aims to equip students with the following skills and knowledge:

- Understanding of various approaches in the work process.
- Familiarity with vocational habilitation/rehabilitation methods to improve work participation for individuals with or without disabilities, or in socio-environmental risk situations.
- Ability to carry out work and job analysis in the work environment using specific tools and methodologies to facilitate work participation.
- Development of skills in the application of specific techniques and work methods for vocational rehabilitation, such as orientation, work training, return to work, job insertion, and follow-up.
- Familiarity with social entrepreneurship as a strategy for employment.

Learning Outcomes:

Upon completion of the course, students will be able to:

- Assess work environments using specific assessment techniques.
- Design and evaluate the work profile of individuals.
- Apply learning in the use of workplace assessment and analysis tools.
- Develop clinical reasoning and case analysis skills and use professional strategies to interpret data and study work methodologies.
- Intervene in processes of orientation, job training, reincorporation, insertion, and job monitoring.
- Design specific competencies for job requalification and return to work.
- Promote the development and knowledge of intervention in the social and work area.
- Understand the core concepts of social entrepreneurship.
- Design community projects oriented to employment.
